Steven Sopp, Senior Planner, reviewed with the Commission a request by EnterSolar on behalf of Unites States Cold Storage for installation of an 810-kilowatt direct current photovoltaic ground mounted solar array.

Chairman Miguel opened the public hearing.

There being no one to speak in favor of or against the project, the public hearing was closed.

Following Commission discussion it was motioned by Commissioner Rocha and seconded by Commissioner Olivares to adopt Resolution 5369, adopting the Mitigated Negative Declaration and approving Conditional Use Permit No. 2020-11 based on the findings and subject to the conditions as listed in the staff report..

Irene Rios, Craig Realty Group, spoke in favor of the project.

Following Commission discussion it was motioned by Commissioner Olivares and seconded by Commissioner Cox to adopt Resolution 5372, approving Variance No. 464 based on the findings and subject to the conditions as listed in the staff report.
