# *Dog Park*



**Dog parks are areas specifically designed for dogs to run free of a leash. They're typically fenced-in areas with different equipment dogs can use to run, climb and jump.**

# PR Commission Recommendation Action to Council

- Receive the recommendation of the Tulare Parks and Recreation Commission and authorize the allocation of \$466,000.00 in Regional Park Development Impact Fee funds to design and construct a Dog Park, located at the 400 Block of N Street.
