RECOMMENDED ACTION

Receive the Public Works performance reports for August 2023.

SUMMARY

Public Works first reported performance dashboards for each of its divisions to the Board of Public Utilities in August 2015 with the intention of inviting additional transparency into the maintenance and operations activities of each of the divisions.

Solid Waste

Overall tonnage was up considerably in August 2023 compared to August 2022. The total tonnage in August 2023 was 5,882.8 tons, an increase of 9.6% compared to August 2022 (5,368.7 tons).

There were 2,980.2 tons collected from residential customers in August 2023, compared to 2,637.0 tons in August 2022, marking an increase of 13.0%.

Commercial tonnage increase compared to a year ago. In August 2023, there were 1,438.8 tons collected from commercial accounts, marking an increase of 5.0% from August 2022 (1,370.3 tons).

Roll-off tonnage was up compared to 2022. There were 1,463.8 tons collected from roll-off operations in August 2023, marking a 7.5% increase from August 2022 (1,361.5).

Overall, the Solid Waste division's recycling rate for August 2023 fell compared to August 2022. The diversion rate for August 2023 was 28 percent (16% green waste, 10% recyclables, 2% food waste/compost). The diversion rate for August 2022 was 32 percent (18% green waste, 12% recyclables, 2% food waste/compost).

The City had a total of 4,207.6 tons of trash (to the landfill), resulting in a rate of 3.78 pounds per person per day for the month of August marking an increase of 10.9% from August 2022 (3.41). The target disposal rate for the City set by the State is 6.0 pounds per person per day.

Water

Water delivery volumes are delayed by one month due to the availability of billing data. In July 2023, water delivery, or water "sold," totaled 549.2 million gallons, 1.5% higher compared to July 2022 (540.9 million gallons). Potable water production experienced a similar rise compared to last year. There were 611.5 million gallons pumped in July 2023, marking a 1.4% increase from July 2022 (603.2 million gallons).

There was a difference of 62.3 million gallons between pumped water (611.5 million gallons) versus delivered (549.2 million gallons), which represents a system loss of a 10.2%.

The primary reason why there is a discrepancy between pumped water and delivered water is when meters are read. Production well data is on a strict calendar month basis. With a growing number of residential meters going to an AMI read (meter to base station), we are developing two distinct cycles – pumped by the calendar and metered from the 15th of the reporting month to the 14th of the following month.

In August 2023, the average standing water level depth was 215 feet, representing a 19-foot rise from a year ago (234 feet). The average standing water level depth remained level compared to July 2023 (215 feet).

Conservation

The overall gross gallons per capita was 275 gallons per person per day in July, 2.2% lower than it was in July 2022 (281).

Residential per capita remained the same compared to a year ago. The residential per capita in July (152 gallons per person) was the same as July 2022 (152 gallons per person). The residential gallons per capita looks specifically at residential water use only.

There were 481 citations handed out in August. There were 85 citations that resulted in a fine (second violations or more). Those fines totaled \$4,685.

Sewer Collections

Preventative Maintenance accounted for 71% of all working man hours in August.

In August, 92,900 of sewer lines were cleaned, and 12,030 feet of sewer lines were televised (preventative maintenance operations).

Approximately 8% of staff's time was spent engaged in administrative tasks related to operating the division.

Waste Water Treatment Plant

In August, the domestic plant's daily influent average was 4.07 million gallons. The domestic plant's capacity is 5.5 million gallons, and when the daily influent average is within 80 percent (4.4 million gallons) of capacity, improvements to the plant's capacity should be a priority.

The industrial plant's daily influent average was 7.89 million gallons in July. The industrial plant's capacity is 12 million gallons, and no daily influent average has been close to the 80-percent mark (9.6 million gallons).

The plant's efficiencies against BOD and TSS remained strong in August, and effluent levels were within state compliance.

Efficiency against BOD was 99.6% in August, the highest efficiency rate thus far in 2023 – and marking the second straight month a 2023-best was set. The combined BOD effluent was 10.0 mg/l, which is within the state compliance level (less than 40 mg/l).

Efficiency against TSS was 98.4% in August, the highest efficiency rate thus far in 2023. The combined TSS effluent was 15.2 mg/l, which is within state compliance (less than 40 mg/l).

Efficiency against Nitrogen was 92.4% in July, the highest efficiency rate thus far in 2023. The combined Nitrogen effluent was 9.1 mg/l, which is within the state compliance (less than 13 mg/l).

We do not have the final nitrogen numbers for August as tests are still being completed. We will report the Nitrogen effluent average and efficiency ratings for August next month.

Operationally, the WWTP completed 357 preventative maintenance work orders and 9 corrective work orders in August. Overall, 175 of the work orders were completed for the Domestic side of the facility and 191 for the Industrial side, 48% and 52%, respectively.






1. BPU Public Works Performance Dashboard Graphic




City of Tulare Water Division August 2023 Dashboard













City of Tulare Sewer Collections/Solid Waste - August 2023 Dashboard

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Award the purchase of one (1) new/unused 2024 Ford F-600 truck with Douglass service body to National Auto Fleet Group of Watsonville, CA using Sourcewell Contract No. 091521-NAF in the amount of \$112,001.23, which includes all fees, tax and shipping.

SUMMARY

The City is a member of Sourcewell, which is a national public service agency that provides for cooperative purchasing for government agencies. Through the Sourcewell Contract No. 091521-NAF, staff is requesting authorization to purchase one (1) new/unused 2024 Ford F-600 truck with Douglass service body from National Auto Fleet Group, of Watsonville, CA in the amount of \$112,001.23.

The proposed truck is a replacement unit and is as follows:

This vehicle was requested for replacement in the FY 2023/24 Fleet Replacement budget in the amount of \$120,000. The cost of the truck does include the Douglass truck service body as requested by the department. The remaining budget left on the truck will be used to finish outfitting the truck for service. The Sourcewell purchasing contract is available to agencies nationwide and is therefore very competitive and very limited. On September 11, 2023, National Auto Fleet Group notified staff that the ordering window for Ford Super Duty trucks was open. This is the first opening we have seen for the bigger trucks. The Fleet Superintendent made contact and was able to place an order for the Ford F-600 truck. Due to the time constraints, the City Manager approved the issuance of a purchase order to secure the truck. If the Board does not approve this item, the build will be canceled, and we will have to wait for the next availability of trucks through the National Auto Fleet Group.

Funding for the purchase of the vehicle will come from the Fleet Replacement Funds for the Water Division (Fund 604).
